

# A Tea Kiosk that's a slice of Kiwi history

The Tea Kiosk building is an important part of New Zealand's heritage.

It was built by the New Zealand government in 1904, along with two other Tea Kiosks in Rotorua & Te Aroha. Those were the days when the government encouraged thermal bathing (due to all the minerals in the water) so the kiosks were built alongside thermal Springs.

The Hanmer Springs Tea Kiosk Café and Grill is the only one still in operation as a cafe. We undertook major refurbishment of the building in 2015, taking care to retain its key heritage features.
